- A 78-year-old paraplegic female has a history of a right leg non-healing wound.
- The wound consists of exposed bone along with necrotic exposed tendon. The patient has been suffering with this non-healing wound for over a year.
- Prior Therapies: the wound was treated with sharp debridement and a plan was put into place for amputation.

Treatment Protocol

HelicollTM Treatment and Results

Helicoll was introduced to the facility and applied to the wound in conjunction with a wound vac.

Granulation was seen with in the first week of treatment and continue to utilize Helicoll in efforts to save the leg.

It is important to note that the patient is in the care of a nursing home facility who will not release records regarding the wound.

The patient has received 6 biweekly Helicoll applications, and as a result will not have leg amputated.
